REFLECTION

Dear parishioners, Friends and Visitors, welcome to St Mary on the Quay. This Sunday the Church celebrates **Fifth Sunday of Lent.**

Today's Gospel reading about the woman taken in adultery provokes several questions. Possibly the most intriguing is 'What did Jesus write on the ground?' But maybe it was just a ploy to divert the attention away



from the pitiable woman in their midst: possibly not fully clothed, certainly in deep fear of her situation. Jesus is compassionate and you could almost say chivalrous. The accusing glares of the religious authorities would have caused her unendurable shame and embarrassment. How had she come to this situation? Was she living in poverty and trying to earn money for herself and possibly her children in order to survive? Or was this a one-off situation with someone that she loved but could not marry? Jesus does not condemn her but neither does he approve. He tells her to go and sin no more. But maybe one of the women who accompanied Jesus on his travels took pity on her and took her to her home and began to help her re-build her life.


